- Provide leadership to the organisation on all media relations, public affairs and commercial sponsorship matters.

Significant experience in Marketing, Branding and Communications is required for this position, preferably within an advocacy or professional services based environment. Candidates should have experience of working effectively with a variety of media channels, across a breadth of subject matter of public interest.

Continuing Professional Development Director

- Responsible for the development and delivery of the Continuing Professional Development (CPD) strategy for Engineers Ireland.
- Lead the strategy development and implementation of Engineers Ireland's educational outreach programme, STEPS (supported by Science Foundation Ireland, Smart Futures).
- Manage relationships with members, employers and educational institutions to ensure that CPD requirements and benefits are fully understood and clearly communicated.

This position requires an experienced leader with a deep understanding of current developments and international best practice in the area of Continuing Professional Development. Significant networking abilities and communications skills are essential for this role, as is the ability to organise and host national events relating to Continuing Professional Development.
